Gladstone Ports Corporation is actively seeking applications from suitably qualified candidates for the role of Trainee Marine Pilot. The Marine Pilots are responsible for safe and efficient pilotage of vessels in the Gladstone Region through the direct application of high level ship handling skill, local port knowledge and general maritime expertise.

Job accountabilities will include:

- Undertake training to gain a valid pilot licence and area endorsement, and to perform the duties of a pilot to meet the operational demands of the region.
- Conduct safe and efficient pilotage of vessels in regional ports through the direct application of a high level of ship handling skill, local port knowledge and general maritime expertise.
- Undertake safety training, updating and familiarisation and assist in marine emergencies as directed.
- Assist in the overall task of port pilotage management, including completion of appropriate documentation and logs in a timely manner.
- Work a roster specific to Gladstone region and form part of a team of pilots that work together to deliver pilotage services.
- Progress through a number of competency levels as professional skills and port specific knowledge is developed to the level of Senior Marine Pilot.

Candidates must respond to the following **key selection criteria** relevant to the role:

Experienced master mariner	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Understands and applies experience master mariner capabilities ideally with ship handling experience as Master or Pilot.• Displays skills necessary to conduct safe and efficient pilotage of ships.• Understands and manages risks, taking the necessary action to mitigate these when appropriate.
Pilotage in Queensland regulatory framework	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Demonstrates knowledge of the regulatory framework pertaining to Pilotage in Queensland.

Candidates must have a valid unrestricted Master Class 1 Certificate of Competency or Master Unlimited Certificate recognised by the Australian Maritime Safety Authority (AMSA) and a valid motor vehicle licence and have rights to work within Australia. Previous experience, including pilot exemptions, will be taken into account.

Failure to provide a written response to the key selection criteria listed above, will result in your application being unsuccessful.

GPC offers, piloting of a wide range of vessel sizes and types, including LNG, passenger and general cargo, pilot launch, helicopter transfer and helicopter winch transfer, work-life balance and a supportive pilotage team.
