

EAST SHORES CONDITIONS OF USE

Gladstone Ports Corporation prides itself on the provision of community facilities for the Gladstone region, including the popular Gladstone Marina Parklands and Spinnaker Park and now, the East Shores - Gladstone Coal Exporters Maritime Precinct.

East Shores is a new precinct funded by Gladstone Ports Corporation and Wiggins Island Coal Export Terminal (WICET), offering a water play park, shade structures, barbeques, public amenities, playgrounds, a boardwalk, a viewing platform and plenty of green, open spaces. East Shores is a world-class recreational precinct for Gladstone residents and visitors of all ages to meet, relax, exercise and enjoy the enhanced waterfront. To help ensure the longevity and vision of this recreational parkland, the following are applicable:



Splash, dance and play in the water play park and playground, but please no smoking, alcohol, glass or dogs in these areas.



East Shores is a venue for everyone for all occasions and as such, cannot be reserved for personal, commercial or community events. However you will still be able to apply for a permit to hold a temporary event within GPC's Marina Parklands and Spinnaker Park.



Please make use of the existing infrastructure and facilities. Marquees, jumping castles, banners, star pickets etc. are not permitted due to the complex underground irrigation and rainwater harvesting system.



Dogs are permitted on the walkways throughout East Shores and must be kept on a leash at all times. Please remove their excrement using the bags provided.
Dogs are not permitted in the water play park.



Bikes, skateboards and scooters are not permitted within the water play park and playground areas.

Whilst enjoying the facilities please be considerate of others and follow the park rules as signed.

Please note that East Shores is under 24hr CCTV surveillance.
