

Gladstone Ports Corporation's Port to Park FunD Run 2023

Terms and Conditions

Definitions

In these Terms and Conditions, capitalised terms have the following meanings:

"Entry Period" means the period from Friday, 9 June 2023 to 10:00am on Wednesday, 16 August 2023.

"Event" means GPC's Port to Park FunD Run, including both the 10km and 3km races.

"Event Date" means Sunday, 20 August 2023.

"GPC" means Gladstone Ports Corporation Limited.

Terms and Conditions

1. By completing the online registration form to participate in the Event, you are accepting the terms and conditions of the Event as detailed below.

Method of Registration

- 2. Online registrations will close at the end of the Entry Period. GPC reserves the right to close online registration at their discretion should the Event reach maximum capacity of participant numbers.
- 3. For an entry to be valid, all participants must complete the online registration form on the GPC website (<u>www.gpcl.com.au</u>) and pay the required entry fee upon registration of the Event.
- 4. All promotional codes to receive a discount on registrations (excluding registrations in the category of 'Children 4yrs and under) must be applied to the registration form for the discount to apply. Only one promotional code will be valid per transaction. The promotional code cannot be applied in conjunction with any other promotions or promotional codes. Refunds will not be issued to participants who fail to use the promotional code at the time of registration.
- 5. Participants no longer select a race shirt size as part of registration. Race Shirts can be collected with your race bib at Race Office. Quantities are limited to 3,300 complimentary race shirts and sizes are varied. Participants acknowledge that race shirts are limited and that there is no guarantee of receiving a race shirt in the event that the race shirts are no longer available.

Event Conditions

- 6. All participants must wear the official race bib at all times during the Event. Registrations are only valid for the participant listed on the registration form and are not transferable (unless authorised by GPC, in its absolute discretion).
- 7. Participants will be placed in categories based on their date of birth provided upon registration for the Event.
- Participants are permitted to enter both the 10km and 3km races, however if the situation arises where a participant places 1st, 2nd or 3rd in both races, the participant will only be eligible to win the placing and appropriate prize money of the 10km race.
- 9. Participants must remain on the official designated course as marked by race officials at all times. Failure to remain on the official designated course will result in immediate disqualification from the Event.
- 10. Both the 10km and 3km races will be timed at the start and finish line by an electronic chip timing system.
- 11. Participants acknowledge that should they withdraw or should the event be cancelled or postponed due to reasons beyond the control of GPC such as safety reasons or poor weather conditions, the entry fee is non-refundable.



- 12. GPC reserves the right to verify the validity of all entries and to disqualify any participant which, in the reasonable opinion of GPC, engaged in conduct at the time of registration which is fraudulent, misleading, deceptive or damaging to the goodwill or reputation of the Event or GPC.
- 13. Due to road closure restrictions, a course cut off time will apply for each race. Any participant who is unable to complete the official designated course by the cut off time will be asked to leave the roadway by race officials for safety reasons.
- 14. All participants accept that GPC's, or any official at the Event acting on behalf of GPC, decision is final and that no correspondence will be entered into. Participants agree to follow all directions by GPC, or any official at the Event acting on behalf of GPC, in relation to the Terms and Conditions.
- 15. GPC reserves the right to restrict entry of any participant to the Event, or remove any participant from the Event, due to behaviour deemed inappropriate by GPC or any other volunteer or employee of GPC.
- 16. Entrants under 18 years of age will require consent to participate from a parent or guardian.
- 17. GPC prohibits the following from the Event for safety reasons including but not limited to bikes, skateboards, rip sticks, rollerblades or similar items. Children in strollers/prams are permitted but should commence at the rear of the race starting line. Strollers/prams or similar devices must meet Australian Safety Standards and have appropriate safety restraints.
- 18. No animals shall be permitted on the official designated course. Assistance animals will be permitted, following notification to GPC.
- 19. GPC reserves the right to amend the terms and conditions of the Event at any time as it sees fit and without notice.

Prizes

- 20. Line honours will determine the winners of each individual category. Individual category winners of the 10km and 3km races will be the first male and female across the line. Second and third prizes will also be awarded. Net time will not determine winners but will be available to participants (approximately 24 hours post event).
- 21. Prizes will be awarded to valid participants crossing the finish line in their categories and finishing positions detailed in this Prizes section of the terms and conditions. If the prize winner is ineligible, the participant may forfeit their prize. Please refer to Prize Information below for further details.
- 22. Prizes will be allocated as per the event terms and conditions to winners in the following categories based on date of birth and age at the time of the event:
 - a) Masters, 10km and 3km
 - i. 1st place Male/Female
 - ii. 2nd place Male/Female
 - iii. 3rd place Male/Female
 - b) Open, 10km and 3km
 - iv. 1st place Male/Female
 - v. 2nd place Male/Female
 - vi. 3rd place Male/Female
 - c) 13 17 years, 10km and 3km
 - vii. 1st place Male/Female
 - viii. 2nd place Male/Female
 - ix. 3rd place Male/Female
 - d) 5-12 years, 10km and 3km
 - i. 1st place Male/Female
 - ii. 2nd place Male/Female
 - iii. 3rd place Male/Female

Limitation of liability

- 23. All participants acknowledge and accept that participation in the Event is at their own risk and may involve risk of physical injury including but not limited to over exertion, dehydration and accidents with other participants, spectators or road users.
- 24. By agreeing to these terms and conditions, participants release GPC and all other Event organisers, sponsors, volunteers, and employees involved in this event from any and all claims arising in respect of the participant's participation in the Event. Participants wholly indemnify GPC and all other Event organisers, sponsors, volunteers, and employees involved in this event directly or indirectly against all liability for any and all injury, loss or damage arising in respect of the participants participation in the Event.
- 25. All participants declare that they are physically capable of participating in the Event and are not aware of any medical condition or impairment that will prevent participation in the Event or will affect their health by participating. If a participant becomes aware of any such condition or impairment or they are injured or sick prior to the Event, they are requested to withdraw from the Event. All participants, at the time of registration, will provide GPC with details of any medical or other condition that may be relevant to any medical treatment that may be required or that may affect their participation in the Event. The participant must advise GPC of any new details of any medical or other condition that may arise prior to the Event but following registration.



Medical services

- 26. Each participant agrees to abide by any advice given by the Event medical officers regarding their health and consent to receive and wholly indemnify GPC for any medical treatment required before, during or after the Event as a result of their participation in the Event.
- 27. Each participant gives the Event medical officers permission to administer any first aid deemed necessary and to transport the participant to a medical facility if deemed necessary.

Privacy and personal information

- 28. Participants confirm that they have obtained and read the GPC Information Privacy Procedure available via a link from www.gpcl.com.au/privacy or by request from GPC, and agree to the collection, use and disclosure of their personal information as described in that Procedure.
- 29. In accordance with Australia's Privacy Act, the names and addresses of all participants in this Event will not be shared or distributed to other parties unless specified.
- 30. Unless they request otherwise by prior notice to GPC, participants consent to the use of their image, photographs, video and comments in any publications and marketing in relation to the Event by GPC. Those publications and marketing may be available globally, in places where Australia's Privacy Act may not apply, even if other overseas privacy laws do. GPC will not be responsible for ensuring that overseas recipients of the information in the publications and marketing follow the specific requirements of Australia's Privacy Act and individuals may not be able to make claims under that Act.

Cancellation

31. GPC reserves the right to cancel or postpone the Event for any reason, in its absolute discretion.

COVID-19

32. Participants must comply with all COVID-19 requirements in accordance with Queensland Health directives at the time of the Event as directed by GPC.
