What is the process and do I have to complete every step?

You must complete all the steps of our process to be considered for an apprenticeship or traineeship. The process will involve the following steps:

- 5. Pre-employment Medicals & Reference Checking
- 6. Offers
- 7. Commencement January 2023.

How do I apply?

- A current resume
- School results Current 2023 and Semester 2 (final) Year 10, Copy of TAFE results (if applicable).

Can I apply for more than one apprenticeship/traineeship?

Yes, you can apply for more than one apprenticeship/traineeship. If you progress through the process, you will be required to choose which discipline you will progress with.

Do I need a colour blind test if I want to apply for an Electrical Apprenticeship?

A colourblind test will be undertake as part of your pre-employment medical.

What are the education requirements?

Prerequisites for 2022 Year 12 Leavers

- Diesel Fitter, Mechanical Fitter and Parks and Gardens: Year 10 completed or completing with SA or higher in English and Math.
- Electrical Apprenticeship: Year 10 completed with SA or higher in English and a high level of Math.

Do I need to complete a medical?

Yes. You will be required to complete a pre-employment medical, this will include a physical component.
