



# GPC Parkland Guidelines

Gladstone Ports Corporation (GPC) prides itself on the provision of community parklands and facilities for the Gladstone region, including the popular Gladstone Marina Parklands, Spinnaker Park and the East Shores Parkland. To help ensure the longevity and vision of our recreational parklands, the following are applicable.



## GLASS

Glass is prohibited in all areas of our parklands. Please view the GPC Parklands maps regarding alcohol consumption.



## RUBBISH

Waste receptacles are provided through the parklands for general users. Please refer to the Queensland Government website regarding use of balloons. Please appropriately dispose of any temporary decorations.



## DOGS

Dogs are permitted within our parklands except in playgrounds, the East Shores water play park and at the outdoor cinema. Dogs must be on a leash at all times and owners are to clean up after their pet. Dog waste bags are provided.



## TEMPORARY INFRASTRUCTURE

Pegs and star pickets are discouraged in all areas of our parklands due to the complex underground irrigation systems. Temporary infrastructure must be weighted down appropriately.



## BIKE, SKATEBOARDS AND SCOOTERS

Bikes, skateboards and scooters are not permitted within the East Shores water play park and/or any of the playground areas. Please use existing parkland pathways and be mindful of other users at all times.

Please note that the East Shores Parkland is under 24hr CCTV surveillance. GPC employees hold Authorised Officer cards issued under the Transport Operations Act 1995.
