

Transport Infrastructure Act 1994 Gladstone Ports Corporation

Port Notice 01/23 Security Restricted Zone – Port of Rockhampton


Take notice that a security restricted zone exists around berth areas within the Port of Rockhampton. Failure to comply with this port notice is an offence against the Transport Infrastructure Act 1994.

A person must not enter within the restricted zone unless authorised to do so by an authorised officer of Gladstone Ports Corporation Limited. Contravention of section 282D (person offending) – 25 penalty units per offence.

A vessel must not enter, stop or anchor within the restricted zone unless authorised to do so by an authorised officer of Gladstone Ports Corporation Limited. Contravention of section 282A (vessel offending) – 100 penalty units per offence.

This zone is in force at all times irrespective of whether a ship is berthed at the berth area. Berth areas include any wharf, berth, jetty, walkway, approach, pylon or other structure associated with maritime operations, as depicted below. The security restricted zone includes:

- a) an area of water within 100 metres from the most eastern face of the berth area:
- b) an area of water within 60 metres from the most northern end of the berth area
- c) an area of water within 40 metres from the most southern end of the berth area;
- d) an area of water within the high water mark and the landside face of the berth area;
- e) an area of water underneath the berth area.
