

Gladstone Ports Corporation's Port to Park Fun Run 2026

Terms and Conditions

Definitions

In these Terms and Conditions, capitalised terms have the following meanings:

"Entry Period" means the online registration period from Thursday, 04 June 2026 to 4pm Thursday, 13 August 2026.

"Event" means GPC's Port to Park Fun Run, including the 10km, 5km and 3km races.

"Event Date" means Sunday, 16 August 2026.

"GPC" means Gladstone Ports Corporation Limited.

Acceptance of Terms

1. **By completing the online registration form to participate in the Event, you are accepting the Terms and Conditions of the Event as detailed below.**

Method of Registration

2. Online registrations will close at the end of the Entry Period. GPC reserves the right to close online registration at its discretion should the Event reach maximum capacity of participant numbers. Limited Race Office registrations may be available at the discretion of GPC; however, availability is not guaranteed and may close at any time.
3. For entry to be valid, participants must complete the online registration form on the GPC website (www.gpcl.com.au) and pay the required entry fee at the time of registration for the Event.
4. Any promotional registration discount codes (excluding registrations in the category of Children 4yrs and under) must be applied during the registration process for the discount to apply. Only one promotional code will be valid per transaction. The promotional code cannot be applied in conjunction with any other promotions or promotional codes. Refunds will not be issued to participants seeking to use a promotional code after the time of registration.
5. Participants do not select a race shirt size during registration as race shirts are not provided as part of the registration fee. Race shirts can be collected with your race bib at Race Office. Approximately 2,850 complimentary race shirts in various sizes are available. Participants acknowledge that race shirts are complimentary and strictly limited. GPC does not guarantee that a race shirt will be available or that a preferred size will be offered.

Event Conditions

6. All participants must wear the official race bib at all times during the Event. Registrations are only valid for the participant listed on the registration form and are not transferable unless authorised by GPC in its absolute discretion.
7. Participants will be placed in categories based on their date of birth provided during registration for the Event.
8. Participants may enter the 10km, 5km and 3km races, however if a participant places 1st, 2nd or 3rd in more than one race, the participant will only be eligible to receive the placing and prize of the longer distance race.
9. Participants must remain on the official designated course as marked by race officials, at all times during the Event. Failure to remain on the official designated course will result in immediate disqualification.
10. All races will be timed at the start and finish by an electronic chip timing system.
11. Participants acknowledge that if they withdraw or if the Event is cancelled or postponed due to reasons beyond GPC's control (including safety issues or poor weather conditions) the entry fee is non-refundable.

12. GPC reserves the right to verify the validity of all entries and to disqualify any participant who, in the reasonable opinion of GPC, engaged in conduct during registration or the Event, which is fraudulent, misleading, deceptive or damaging to the goodwill or reputation of the Event or GPC.
13. Due to road closure restrictions, a course cut off time will apply for each race. Any participant who is unable to complete the official designated course by the cut-off time will be asked to leave the roadway by race officials for safety reasons.
14. All participants accept that any decision by GPC, or any official at the Event acting on behalf of GPC, is final and no correspondence will be entered into. Participants agree to follow all directions issued by GPC, or any official at the Event acting on behalf of GPC, in relation to these Terms and Conditions.
15. GPC reserves the right to restrict entry to any participant into the Event, or remove any participant from the Event, due to behaviour deemed inappropriate by GPC, or any official at the Event acting on its behalf.,
16. Participants under 18 years of age must have consent from a parent or guardian to participate in the Event.
17. GPC prohibits the following from the Event for safety reasons including but not limited to bicycles, e-bikes and scooters, skateboards, rip sticks, rollerblades or similar items. Children in strollers/prams are permitted to accompany participants on the official designated course but must commence at the rear of the starting line. Strollers/prams or similar devices used during the Event must meet Australian Safety Standards and have appropriate safety restraints fitted and used at all times.
18. No animals are permitted on the official designated course. Assistance animals are permitted, provided prior notification is given to GPC.
19. GPC reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions at any time as it sees fit and without notice.

Prizes

20. Line honours will determine the winners of each race distance and the prizes to be awarded to registered participants. The winners of the 1st place prizes for the 10km, 5km and 3km races will be the first male and first female across the finish line. 2nd and 3rd place prizes will also be awarded in each race distance. Net time will not be used to determine winners but will be available to participants (approximately 24 hours post event).
21. Prizes will be awarded to registered participants crossing the finish line 1st, 2nd or 3rd in each race distance no matter age however, participants in the Children 4 years and under category are not eligible to be prize winners. The prizes to be awarded are in accordance with finishing positions described in the Prize Information below.
22. If a prize winner is found by GPC, for any reason to be invalid, the participant will forfeit their prize. The forfeited prize will be awarded to the next highest valid finisher in the relevant category, with their prize (if any) awarded to the next valid finisher and so on as required.
23. Prizes will be allocated in accordance with the Event Terms and Conditions to winners in each race distance as follows:
 - a) 10km, 5km and 3km overall
 - i. 1st place Male/Female
 - ii. 2nd place Male/Female
 - iii. 3rd place Male/Female

Limitation of liability

24. All participants acknowledge and accept that participation in the Event is at their own risk and may involve risk of physical illness or injury and/or accidents with other participants, spectators or road users or other risks.
25. By registering for the Event participants agree to these Terms and Conditions, and release GPC and all other Event organisers, sponsors, volunteers, and employees involved in the Event from any and all claims arising from the participant's participation in the Event. Participants fully indemnify GPC and all other Event organisers, sponsors, volunteers, and employees involved in the Event directly or indirectly against all liability for any and all injury, loss or damage suffered or caused to be suffered, arising in respect of their participation in the Event.
26. All participants declare that they are physically capable of participating in the Event and are not aware of any medical condition or impairment that may prevent participation in the Event or adversely affect their health. If a participant becomes aware of any such condition or impairment or is injured or unwell prior to the Event, they are required to withdraw. All participants, at the time of registration, must provide GPC with details of any medical or other condition that may be relevant to any medical treatment that may be required or that may affect their participation in the Event. The participant must advise GPC of any new medical or other condition that arises following registration and prior to the Event.

Medical services

27. Each participant agrees to abide by any advice given by the Event medical officers regarding their health and consent to receive and fully indemnify GPC for any medical treatment required before, during or after the Event as a result of their participation.
28. Each participant authorises Event medical officers to administer any first aid deemed necessary and to arrange and facilitate transport to a medical facility if required.

Privacy and personal information

29. Participants confirm that they have obtained and read the GPC Information Privacy Procedure available at www.gpcl.com.au/privacy or upon request from GPC, and agree to the collection, use and disclosure of their personal information as described in the Procedure.
30. In accordance with Australia's Privacy Act, the names and addresses of all participants will not be shared or distributed to third parties unless permitted under the Act or otherwise specified.
31. By registering to participate, you acknowledge that photography, filming and recording may occur before, during and after the Event. You consent to GPC collecting and using your image, likeness, photographs, video and comments for Event related publications and marketing purposes. This includes use in GPC publications, marketing materials, websites, social media channels and other online platforms. These materials may be distributed globally, including in countries where Australia's Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) may not apply. You understand that GPC is not responsible for ensuring that overseas recipients comply with Australian privacy requirements, and that you may not be able to seek remedies under the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) for overseas use.
32. If registering a participant under the 18 years of age, you confirm that you are the parent or legal guardian and that you provide consent on behalf of the minor for their image or likeness to be collected, used and disclosed in accordance with this clause. GPC will not intentionally identify minors by name in marketing materials without additional consent.
33. If you (or, for minors, the parent or legal guardian) do not wish to be photographed or filmed, you are responsible for taking reasonable steps to avoid being captured. This may include avoiding designated photography or filming areas and making choices that minimise the likelihood of appearing in crowd or background imagery. While GPC will use reasonable efforts to respect such preferences, GPC cannot guarantee that incidental capture will not occur.

Cancellation

34. GPC reserves the right to cancel or postpone the Event for any reason, in its absolute discretion.
